God Answers Job: Job 38:1-7, 34-41;

QUESTIONS

- What were some of the questions God asked Job?
- What do those questions reveal to us about God?
- In Isaiah 53:6, what does it mean by we [people] are like sheep?
- Read Isaiah 53:10. What was the result of everything that happened to Jesus?
- Why do you think God only shows us a small part of the big picture?
- How is Jesus a part of God's big picture?
- How are you a part of God's big picture?

ACTIVITY

Have the kids decorate a picture frame. Explain to them that although we don't know what picture will go in the frame, we can prepare for it now.

Today, we're decorating some picture frames. We may not have pictures to go in them just yet, but we can still have the frame ready!

How is this similar to getting ready for God's big picture? We may not know what the big picture will be, but we can trust that God will keep us safe and that God's plan for us is the best. **How can we be ready to be a part of what God is doing?**
