THE BIBLE

Job's Sufferings: Job 1:1, 2:1-10;
Psalm 8

QUESTIONS

- What two words does God use to describe Job?
- What are some ways Job suffered?
- Does Job do anything wrong while suffering?
- Read Psalm 8:3-4. How does it make you feel to look up at the stars and know that they were made by God's own hands?
- How does it make you feel to know God is so big?
- How do we know God is with us even when things are hard?
- What can we do when we go through tough times?

ACTIVITY

Using a big piece of bulletin board paper or butcher paper, encourage the kids to finger paint a night sky and leave their handprints at the very bottom.

Let's read Psalm 8:3 again together. God's own fingers put the moon and stars in the sky. God is so big! So, today we are going to create a night sky with our fingers! Every time you see your work of art, remember that the Earth and everything in it is God's artwork.

We are small, but God is big! And God cares about us in big, unimaginable ways.
