THE BIG IDEA

Jesus connects us to each other.

THE BIBLE

Jesus Appears to the Disciples: John 20:19-31;
(I John 1:1-4)

QUESTIONS

- When Jesus came into the room, what did Jesus say to the disciples?
- What did Thomas say to the other disciples when they told him they saw Jesus alive?
- For Thomas to believe, what did Jesus show Thomas?
- Read I John 1:3. What do you think it means to have fellowship with God?
- Fellowship is one way to say we are connecting with others. What are some ways we connect with others in general?
- Who are the people you are connected with when you believe in Jesus?
- What is one thing you can do to connect more people to your community of people who know and love God?

ACTIVITY

In each of the spaces provided on the printable, have kids write something they can do to improve their connection with others this week (e.g., video call with long distance friend, send a kind message, help out with a chore, write a letter, send a care package, etc.).

Jesus connects us to each other, but it's our job to maintain the connection! **What can we do this week to strengthen our relationships with the people we're connected to?** Hang this up at home where you can see it everyday. Check off every time you do one of the activities you wrote down. Try to climb to the top!
