THE BIBLE

Jesus Clears the Temple: John 2:13-22;
(Psalm 19:7-11)

QUESTIONS

- Why did the Jews celebrate the Passover?
- Where did Jesus go to celebrate the Passover?
- What did Jesus say would happen to the temple after it was destroyed?
- Read Psalm 19:10. According to this verse, what is the Bible better than?
- Where can you find God's plan for your life?
- How can the Bible help you with something from school last week?
- What is one way you know God's plans are perfect?

ACTIVITY

Tell the kids to write the blueprints for what they will do this week. On three separate papers, instruct the kids to draw a house, a school, and a church. Encourage them to write or draw things that will need to happen in each place: spending time with God, sharing their story, using their gifts, spending time with others, learning, giving, serving, getting help from each other.

What will you do this week to follow these blueprints in your life?
