THE BIBLE

The Third and Fourth Commandments:
Exodus 20:7-11; 32:1-14; (Philippians 4:8-9)

QUESTIONS

- What is the third commandment?
- What is the fourth commandment?
- What do these commandments tell us about worshipping God?
- Re-read Exodus 20:7-11 aloud. What are some ways you can “keep the Sabbath holy?”
- Why do we worship God?
- Why do you think it’s important to set aside a day for God?
- What are some ways you worship God?

ACTIVITY

Brainstorm different ways we can worship God: prayer journal, walking in nature, singing, dancing, creating art, giving money or items to people in need, etc. Help the kids create a list of ways to worship that they can take home and use as a map on their daily road trip through life!
