THE BIG IDEA

Wait and see, God will do impossible things.

THE BIBLE

An Angel Appears to Mary:
Luke 1:26-38; (Psalm 89:1-8)

QUESTIONS

- What was the name of the angel that God sent to tell about Jesus?
- Why would Mary have thought that what the angel was saying would be impossible?
- How did Mary respond to the message?
- Read Psalm 89:6-8. What does it mean that no one can compare to God?
- What is something that you are waiting on God to do in your life (or in someone else's life) that seems impossible?
- How can we be more like Mary while waiting?
- Why do you think it is important for us to praise God while waiting for the impossible?

ACTIVITY

Divide the kids into small groups. Have each of the small groups get together and write a song about the Bible story and the Big Idea for the week. The kids can choose a melody from a favorite Christmas song and rewrite the lyrics together. If time allows, have the small groups share their songs with one another!

This time of year is filled with songs and carols about God's great love for us being shown through the birth of Jesus. It is incredible that love has a name, and it's Jesus! If we continue to **wait and see, God will do impossible things!**
