- Read Colossians 1:13-14. What has God done for us that shows we can have faith?
- What does having faith mean to you?
- Think of someone else in the Bible who had faith in God. How did their faith help them?
- What is one thing you can do this week to show you have faith in God?

## ACTIVITY

*Walk kids through how to build the model airplanes using the materials you have prepared.*
