- Read Colossians 3:2. What does it mean to "set your mind on things above"?
- Name someone in your life that God used to help you in some way.
- Why can it be difficult to be used by God?
- What can you do to be used by God in everyday life?

Have the kids write themselves a letter to remind them how they can be used by God.

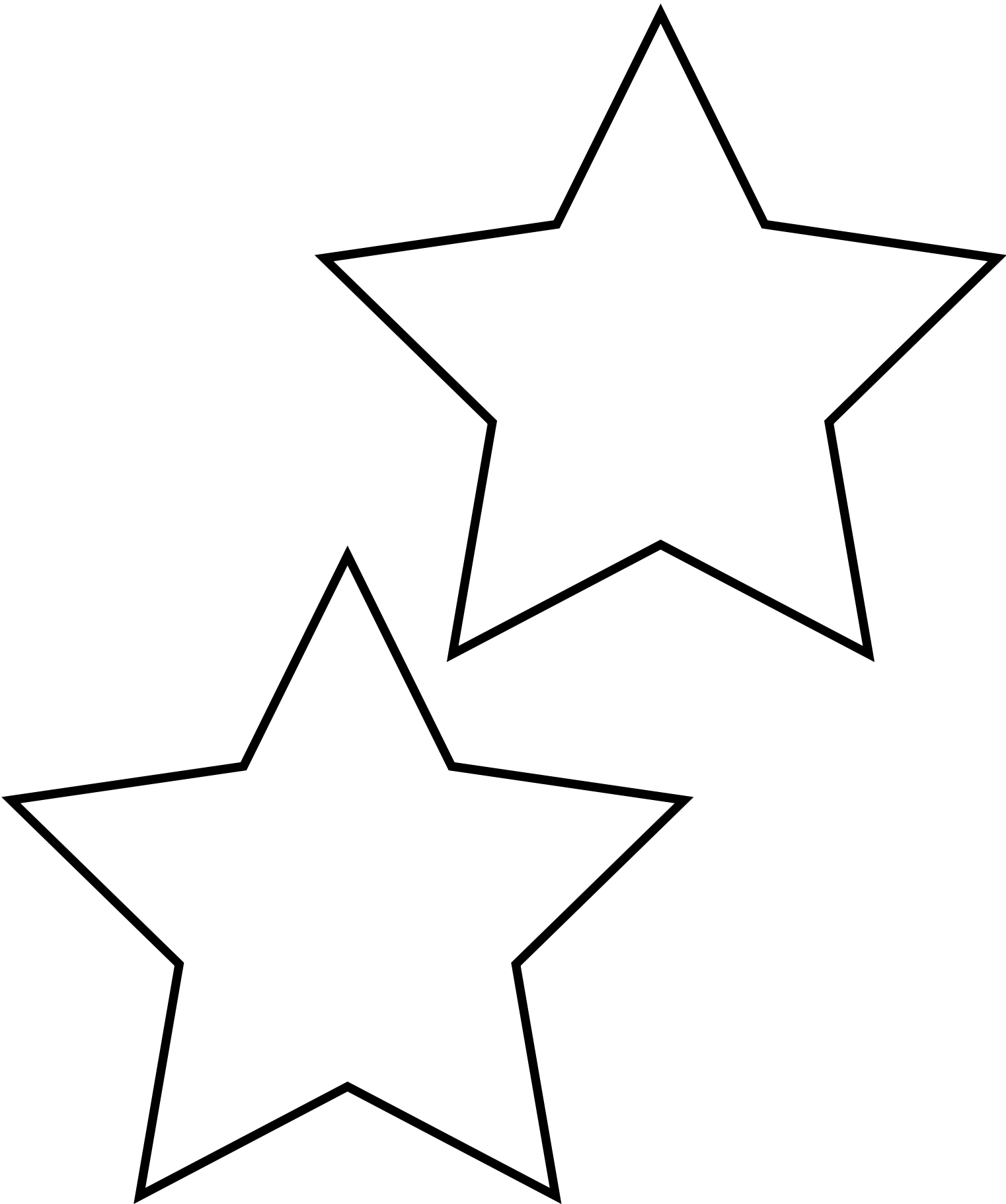
I know that God made you with special gifts and talents. Even the things that you dream and hope for are all special things about you. God will use you to help others and to help others know God more.

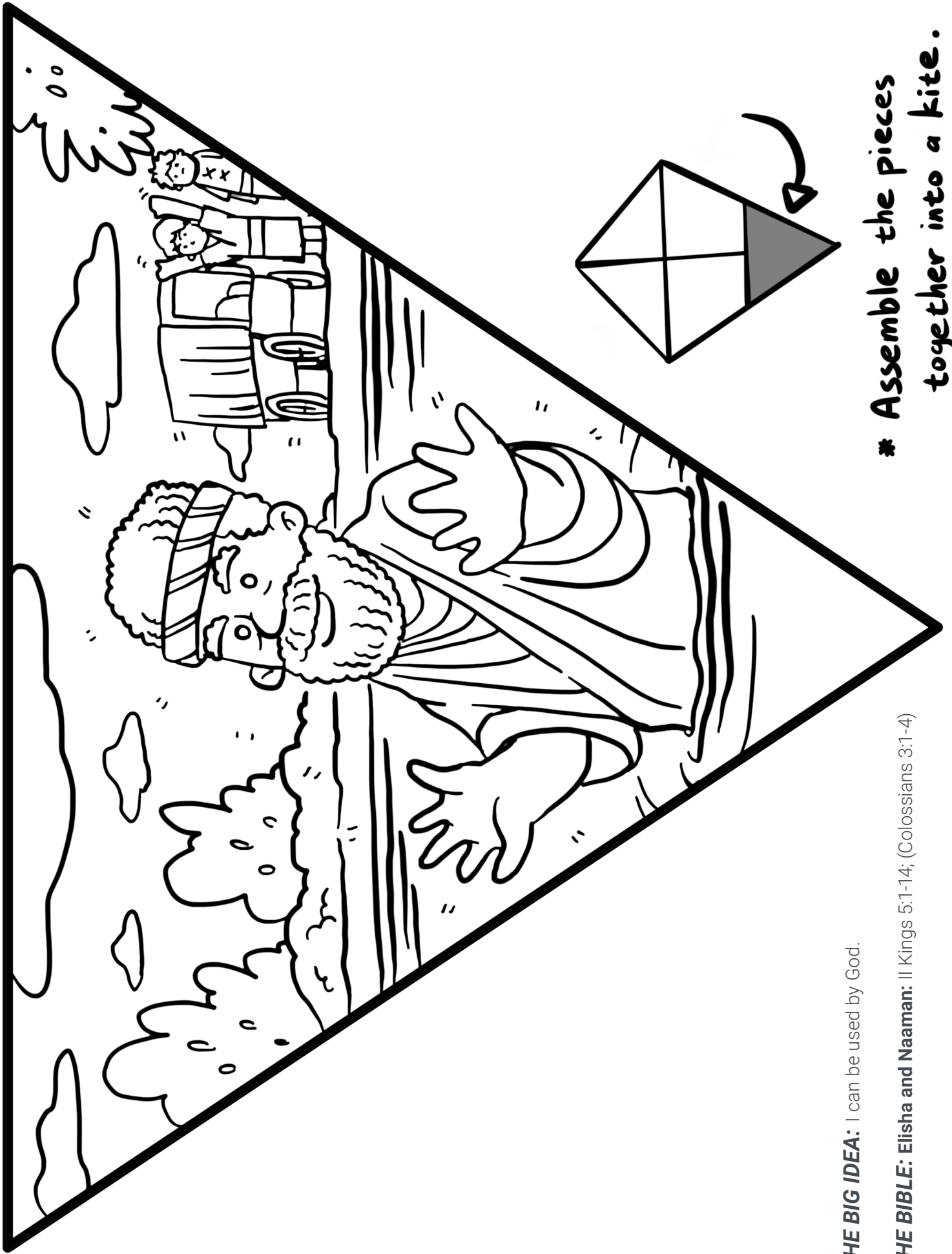
