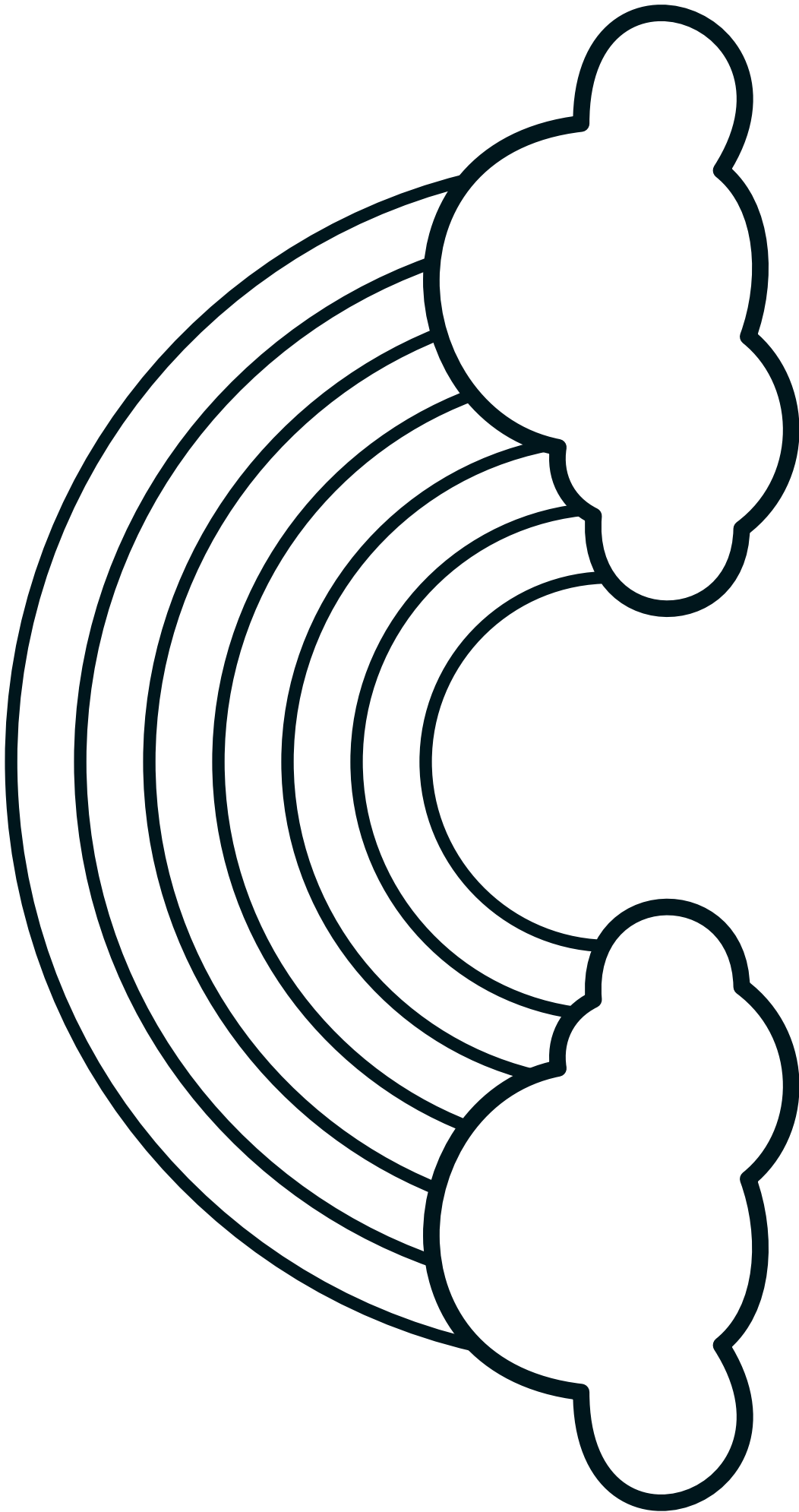
The Bible is filled with promises from God to us that God always keeps. **Which one of these do you find most comforting?**

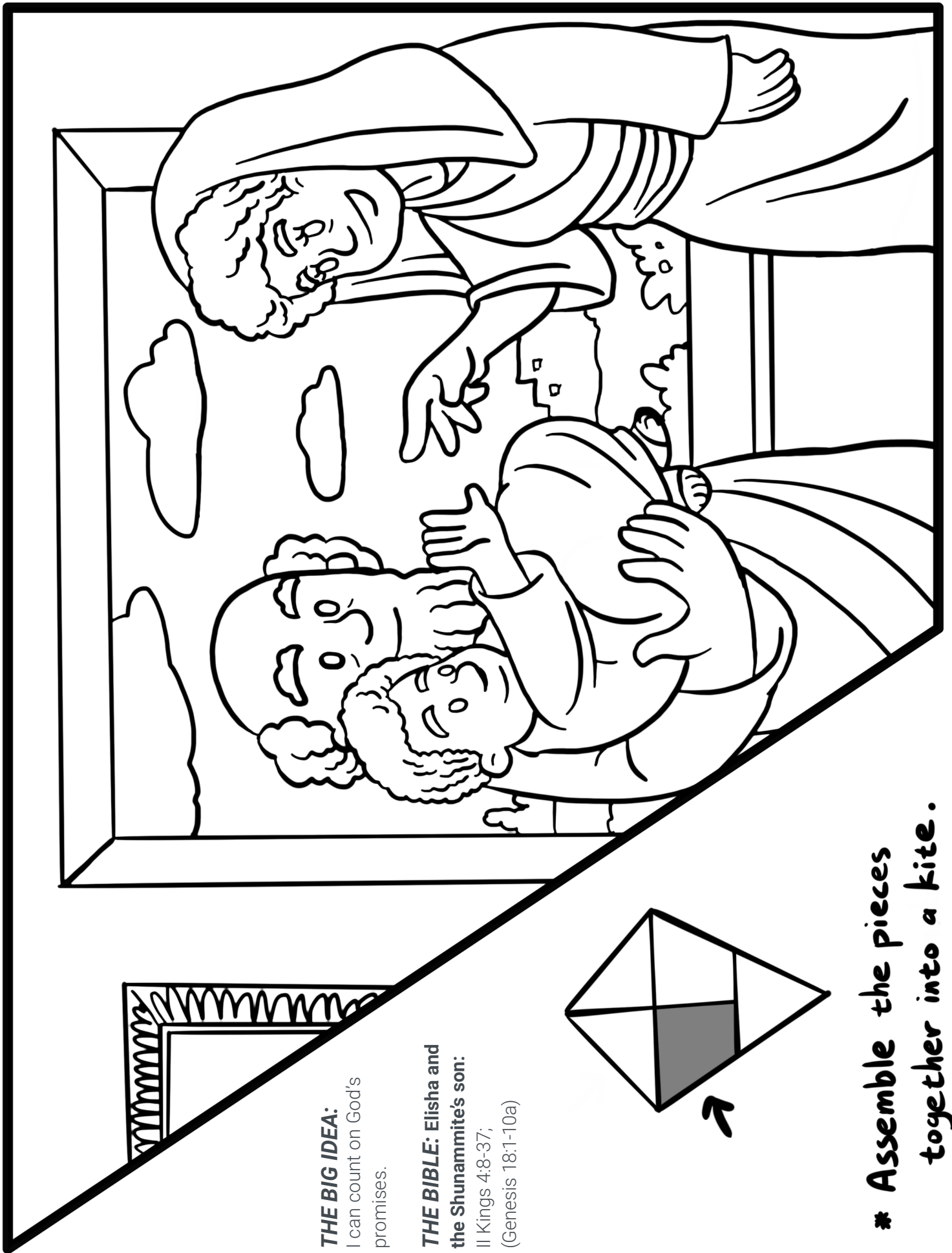
